#### 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

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<b>Spills &amp; Disposal</b>	Personnel involved in cleaning up any spills are to wear gloves and goggles. If there is the possibility of a fire, then personnel should also wear self-contained breathing apparatus. Cordon off the spillage area. Isolate the source of the spillage or leak. Contain the spillage using a suitable non-flammable absorbent material such as sand or diatomaceous earth, and then transfer into sealed plastic containers for disposal.

## 10. STABILITY AND REACTIVITY

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<b>Chemical Stability</b>	Considered stable to heat and light. Store below 30°C. Keep out of direct sunlight.
<b>Conditions to Avoid</b>	None known.
<b>Incompatible Materials</b>	Strong oxidizing agents.
<b>Hazardous Decomposition Products</b>	Upon heating or if this product is involved in a fire, the water and isopropanol contained in the product may evaporate, leaving a combustible residue behind. During combustion, this residue may produce carbon monoxide as well as other unidentifiable organic compounds.
