

# Education in Spain

Spain one of the countries with a long history of development of the education system. Founded in 1218 the Salamanca University is the oldest in the country. The Spaniards are very serious about their education. Training for children starts with preschool education. Children in such places take several months. Along with public educational institutions in the country common private and religious schools. The latter two accept students on a fee basis. Attend private and religious schools is considered very prestigious.

For residents of the country free and compulsory secondary education. After receiving the certificate of the Spaniards can choose two ways. To get a profession and go to work. Or to continue their education in high school and go to University.

Final exams in high school are opening in universities.

Spanish universities are public, private, and spiritual. In any of these paid education. But it costs quite reasonable money.

A three-stage higher education: bachelor, master, doctor. Most universities are located in Madrid and Barcelona.

The training program is drawn up by the University. Usually it is clearly structured and unchanging. A student may not change the University in the process of learning.

At most universities the academic year is divided into 2 semesters, some may be three.

Classes are held exclusively in Spanish, so the foreign students mandatory entrance exam for language skills.

The request for admission must be submitted to each individual University. As Spanish universities there is no overall system, each with its own entrance examinations and deadlines for applications. Competition for space can be very high. Most universities accept about 5% of foreign students.

For students from EU countries it is sufficient to have a certificate of graduation exams in the high school of his country for admission. For the other students to translate copies of education certificates and identity card, to assure them and to refer for confirmation to the Ministry of Education of Spain.

Many universities offer for foreign students, special summer courses in the Spanish language. You can also tighten up the language in a private school. For the University will require the diploma DELE.

Knowledge of students, as in many European countries, are determined with the help of loans, which are placed instead of grades.

So for example, the bachelor after 4 years of training should be 240 credits, the master 60-120.

In Spain also have an unofficial degree and graduate educational institutions. The degree of specificity of each University. It is not listed outside of Spain. But allows you to get a good job.

Spain is open to exchange students from other countries.

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
